TREASURER'S OFFICE

Important Information Regarding Your Summer Tax Bills

- Summer Property Taxes are payable July 1, 2017 to September 15, 2017. A late payment penalty of 4% will be applied starting September 16, 2017.
- If your taxes are paid by a mortgage company and you do not see a mortgage code, forward this bill to your mortgage company.
- Failure to receive a Tax Bill does not waive the late payment penalty or fee.
- <u>Deferment of Summer Taxes:</u> If your gross income did not exceed \$40,000 for the preceding

calendar year and you meet other Michigan Department of Treasury deferment requirements, you may be eligible to apply to defer the due date of your summer taxes without penalty or interest charges until February 28, 2018. An annual deferment form must be completed, signed, and submitted to the City on or before September 15th.

• Check Policy: Checks are accepted only as conditional payment. If it is not honored by the bank, taxes are considered unpaid and subject to penalties and interest. A fee is assessed each time a check is returned unpaid. Your cancelled check is your receipt.

Errors and Omissions: Examine your statement closely for corrections. If your principal residence exemption percentage is incorrect, contact the Assessor's Office at 586.469.6818 x4 to inquire about your appeal rights. Please return this bill if you no longer own this property.

Did You Receive a Past Due Notice?

Contact the Treasurer's Office if you need to make payment arrangements for a past due water/ sewer bill. If you are unable to pay your bill in full, you will need to signup to make monthly payments to continued on page 4

Labor Day

Monday, September 4, 2017 There will be NO garbage pickup on Monday, September 4th. Pickup will run one day behind schedule for the entire week beginning Monday, September 4th, through Friday, September 8th. Regular garbage pickup will resume on Monday, September 11, 2017.

Columbus Day

Monday, October 9, 2017 Garbage pickup will run on schedule during the entire month of October.

Dogs and Cats

Mount Clemens takes all stray animals to the Macomb County Animal Shelter. You may contact them at 586.469.5115. If an animal is licensed and wearing tags, the owner will be notified that the pet has been found.

Please be a responsible pet owner and follow these City policies:

• ALL DOGS AND CATS MUST BE LICENSED by January 1st of each year. A current RABIES vaccination certificate WITH EXPIRATION DATES must be presented for either species in order to obtain a license.

- A household may have a total of four (4) dogs or cats, or a combination of both totaling 4.
- ALL DOGS OR CATS MUST WEAR LICENSE TAGS when outside a building or residence or otherwise outdoors.
- All dogs and cats shall be kept under restraint (leashed) and NOT PERMITTED TO BE AT LARGE.

DOGS AND CATS MUST BE LICENSED even if they never leave the house.

2017 Sidewalk Repair Program

• The City of Mount Clemens is • implementing a Sidewalk Repair Program, consisting of the removal and replacement of defective concrete sidewalks. Each resident is responsible for the repair of hazardous sidewalks located in front of their property as indicated in the City of Mount Clemens Ordinance

• The program will begin in District 1

• Crest, N. Esplanade, and Huntington

An inspector will mark defective sidewalks approximately one month before construction begins. If any sidewalk was found to require

- replacement in front of or at the side
- of your property, it will be marked
- with one of two markings: a "C"
- indicates the "CITY'S RESPONSIBILITY"
- for replacement and cost; and • an "X" indicates the "OWNER'S
- **RESPONSIBILITY**" for the replacement

and cost.

There are two (2) options available for the replacement of the sidewalk:

OPTION #1

The City has selected a licensed contractor through a competitive bid process to perform the identified sidewalk repairs. The City will invoice the property owner, who will be responsible for the cost associated with these repairs.

OPTION #2

The property owner may hire a licensed contractor to perform the necessary sidewalk repairs. The contractor must obtain a permit from the City of Mount Clemens Building Department before any work begins.



Block Parties Build Community

There are many ways that a neighborhood and its residents can create a strong sense of community. One important way is by utilizing tools such as a Neighborhood Watch program to decrease opportunities for criminals to commit crimes. Another way is to make use of events such as a block party. Block parties are an excellent opportunity for neighbors to get together, meet each other, have fun, and maybe work together on a common activity, such as an alley clean-up or helping a neighbor that is in need.

The City encourages its residents to have block parties, which can vary in size and activities. If you wish to close a street for a block party, you simply fill out and submit a Block Party Permit Application to the Community Development Department. You will need signatures from at least 51% of the homeowners that will be impacted

continued from page 1 prevent a service shut off. Once a shut-off is initiated, a \$25 service fee applies and the entire balance is due. You can prevent a shut-off by simply going to the Treasurer's Office at City Hall and making payment arrangements. Cash, check, money order or credit/debit cards are accepted.

If you are unable to make a payment towards your past due bill, contact an agency for help as soon as possible, by simply calling 211.
