Winter Snow Removal & Snow **Emergency Information**

Please keep in mind the Street Department will be clearing all major streets first during a snow storm. We will, however, plow the side streets as quickly as possible once the major streets are clear.

This winter during snowstorms, please • park your vehicles at an off-street location. Parking in a driveway or parking lot will be greatly appreciated. On-street parking can resume after the City has plowed the Office at 586.469.6818 x1. Any tax streets.

Whenever there is an abundance of snow accumulated or there is a possibility that snow will accumulate to extraordinary depths, the City may declare a "Snow Emergency." Local television and radio news stations will be alerted when a snow emergency has been declared and cancelled, so tune in for this information during snow storms or excessive snow falls.

After the initial notice of a snow emergency has been declared, please remove all vehicles within six (6) hours on any major streets and/or within twelve (12) hours on local streets or alleys. Once the entire street has been cleared of snow from curb to curb and no additional snow has accumulated or is predicted to accumulate, vehicles may then resume parking on that street.

Compost/Leaf Pickup Season Ends December 8th

The City of Mount Clemens will again be enforcing its leaf pick up policy this fall. All leaves that do not fall into the street from the trees MUST be placed in 30-gallon brown waste bags or 25- to 35-gallon refuse containers marked "compost" or "yard waste."

ABSOLUTELY NO RAKING OR BLOWING LEAVES INTO THE STREET. IF YOU HAVE A LANDSCAPING COMPANY, PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT THEY ARE AWARE OF THIS POLICY. YOUR COMPLETE COOPERATION WILL BE APPRECIATED.

CABLE TELEVISION

MAJOR IMPROVEMENTS TO YOUR CABLE STATION!

Recently, the staff of the Macomb Cable Network completed a fiveyear project, which converted the entire television station to High Definition (HD). The project began by replacing the cameras and editing computers with HD ones. Next, the studio was converted to HD. The network was upgraded to handle

the larger files and traffic flow and finally, the playback was replaced this August with HD compatible equipment. The signals for the Government, Education and Public Access channels will still be sent out in Standard Definition, until Comcast and WOW! make theses channel available in HD.

Election Day

Election Day is Tuesday, November 7, 2017. Polling places will be open from 7:00 AM until 8:00 PM. On the ballot for Mount Clemens voters will be the office of Mayor for a two-year term, which expires in November 2019; and three seats on the City Commission for a four-year term, which expires November 2021.

The last day to register to vote in this election is Tuesday, October 10, 2017.



Voting **Equipment** The City of Mount Clemens, along with

all the municipalities in Michigan, is receiving brand new voting equipment as part of a state-wide

change over. There will be no cost to the City, as the equipment will be funded with federal funds through the Help America Vote Act. As a result, all of the local governments in Macomb County will now be using the same equipment serviced by the $\, \bullet \,$ a very walkable community, with an same company, Electronic Systems

Voters will not experience any changes in the voting procedure. The optical scan system, in which voters mark a paper ballot and feed it through an optical scanning machine, will still be utilized. The new equipment will be on display at City Hall for residents to view before the November Election,

Snow and Ice Removal Required

- the warm weather of late summer
- and early fall, it is important to look
- ahead to the upcoming winter
- season that will be here shortly. As
- extended network of sidewalks, it is
- critical that residents and businesses
- do their part to keep the sidewalks
- clear of snow and ice.
- City ordinances require that "The
- occupant of any premises, or the
- owner of any unoccupied premises,
- is required to keep the sidewalks in
- front of or adjacent to such premises
- cleared, so far as is practicable
- and reasonable, from snow and • ice to facilitate pedestrian use.
- Where there are no sidewalks, the
- occupant or owner shall clear a
- path free from snow and ice where
- a sidewalk would otherwise be, to
- facilitate pedestrian use. Whenever

any snow or ice has fallen or accumulated, it shall be cleared within 12 hours after it has fallen or accumulated." Failure to remove the snow and ice according to the timeframe of the ordinance may result in the City of Mount Clemens performing this task and placing a lien against the property for all costs incurred, or issuing violation notices against the property.

It will redirect you to the Municode.com site which has all of the ordinances for Mount Clemens. We all hope this winter season is not as harsh as the last two, but in the event that it is, thank you for your diligence in keeping the sidewalks of Mount Clemens safe.
