Labor Day

Monday, September 2, 2019 There will be NO garbage pickup on Monday, September 2nd. Pickup will run one day behind schedule for the entire week beginning Monday, September 2nd, through Friday, September 6th. Regular garbage pickup will resume on Monday, September 9, 2019.

Columbus Day

Monday, October 14, 2019 Garbage pickup will run on schedule during the entire month of October.

Leaf Pickup Policy

The City of Mount Clemens will again be enforcing its leaf pick up policy this fall. RAKING AND BLOWING LEAVES INTO THE STREET IN THE CITY OF MOUNT CLEMENS IS PROHIBITED. All leaves that do not fall into the street from the trees **MUSI** be placed in 30-gallon brown waste bags or 25to 35-gallon refuse containers.

ABSOLUTELY NO RAKING OR BLOWING LEAVES INTO THE STREET. IF YOU HAVE A LANDSCAPING COMPANY, PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT THEY ARE AWARE OF THIS POLICY.

YOUR COMPLETE COOPERATION WILL BE APPRECIATED.

The City will schedule a clean-up crew to come down every street at least twice during this season to pick up the leaves that have fallen from the trees. The City will not release a schedule due to the uncertain weather conditions during the Fall season.

A City contracted yard waste collection truck will operate through December 6, 2019 only. This truck will pick up only properly contained and bundled yard waste. YARD WASTE

IN PLASTIC BAGS WILL NOT BE PICKED

UP. Brush piles and yard waste must be placed in 30-gallon brown waste bags or 25- to 35-gallon refuse containers that weigh 50 pounds or less. Brush must be cut into four-feet lengths and tied in bundles. Bundles must not weigh more than 50 pounds or be over 18" in diameter. Large logs and branches over 3" in diameter, as well as stumps or roots, will not be picked up for collection.

Place all yard waste at curbside no earlier than 6 PM the day before your scheduled pick up day and

NO LATER THAN 7:00 AM of your scheduled pick up day.

Please remember that following City policy will not only be appreciated by the City of Mount Clemens, but also by your neighbor who has been taking the time to bag their leaves.

Lost Dogs/Cats

Mount Clemens takes all stray animals to the Macomb County Animal Shelter. You may contact them at 586.469.5115 to locate a lost animal. If an animal is licensed and wearing tags, the owner will be notified that the pet has been found.

Please be a responsible pet owner and following these City policies:

• ALL DOGS AND CATS MUST BE LICENSED by January 1st of each year. A current RABIES vaccination certificate WITH EXPIRATION DATES must be

.

- presented for either species in order to obtain a license.
- A household may have a total of four (4) dogs or cats, or a combination of both totaling (4).
- ALL DOGS OR CATS MUST WEAR LICENSE TAGS when outside a building or residence or otherwise outdoors.
- All dogs and cats shall be kept under restraint (leashed) and NOT PERMITTED TO BE AT LARGE.

DOGS AND CATS MUST BE LICENSED even if they never leave the house.

Dogs and Cats..

As the weather gets warmer, people and their pets will be outdoors more often. Keep your pet on a leash or in a secured area for the safety of your neighbors as well as your pets. When you walk your pet, as a courtesy to your neighbors, please make sure you clean up after them. Also, the City does require that dogs and cats are licensed. If you need to obtain a license, they are available at the Treasurer's Office at One Crocker Boulevard with proof of current vaccinations.

Knock" list as a further reminder to the solicitors.

Door-to-door solicitation is permitted in Mount Clemens, however, all solicitors must be licensed by the City and possess a solicitor's license from the City Clerk's Office. Exempt from the license requirement are charitable organizations, religious organizations and candidates running for office. Licensed door-todoor solicitors are only permitted to call on residences between the hours of 10:00 AM and 7:00 PM.

Residents are advised not to provide any information to door-to-door solicitors, such as copies of utility or phone bills. Account numbers can be lifted from these documents and unauthorized switching of companies can occur. Please contact the Macomb County Sheriff's Office at 586.469.5151 for complaints about solicitors.

Summer Tax Bills

All residents should have received their 2019 Summer Tax Bill. If your taxes are paid by your mortgage company, please keep this for your records. Summer taxes are due by September 16, 2019. If you are • unable to pay the entire amount • due, you may make payments

- toward your balance at any time, • starting July 1st. We do not make
- payment arrangements on taxes. If
- paying in person, we will issue you a
- receipt with your remaining balance due. After September 16th, a 4% flat penalty will be added to any remaining balance. This amount will not be penalized again until March 1, 2020, when it is turned over to the Macomb County Treasurer's Office.

Senior Tax Deferments For Taxes

• December 31, 2019, (or you are

permanently disabled) and your income for the preceding calendar year did not exceed \$40,000, you are eligible to apply for a deferment of your summer property taxes. This form must be signed each year between July 1st and the September due date (this year September 16th) and will give you until February 28, 2020 to pay your summer taxes without penalty.
